

Derek is employed at Publix and Jessica is a preschool teacher for Early Headstart. Currently, they live with a family member in an overcrowded environment. Derek and Jessica have been desperately looking for a better living situation but rising rental costs have made it impossible. They learned about the Habitat Homeownership Program and knew this was an opportunity that could change their lives. Jessica said, "Habitat for Humanity will be our saving grace and will allow us to give our children a better environment to grow up in." Our local affordable housing crisis is no surprise; add a pandemic, and the crisis worsens. Families are finding it harder to make ends meet due to escalating housing costs. We receive an average of 90 housing assistance inquiries a month. The need for affordable homeownership is greater than ever.

Charlotte County Habitat for Humanity's Board of Directors approved our fiscal year budget to support building 30 homes for qualified, deserving families. Because we have an unprecedented amount of qualified applicants, we have increased our home builds to 33. We currently have 36 families approved in our Homeownership Program, more than any time in our 33 year history. Some families will have to wait almost two years to purchase their Habitat home.

The COVID-19 pandemic and local shut downs caused a significant loss of revenue. Our resale stores were closed for six weeks, we had to cancel or postpone fundraising events and we saw a decline in individual donations. In order to raise necessary funds for families like Derek and Jessica, Charlotte County Habitat is embarking on an 'Annual Home Build Campaign'. The 'Annual Home Build Campaign' will run from October 15, 2020 thru February 28, 2021 with a goal of raising \$200,000. All money raised in this campaign will go directly into building homes for families in Charlotte County.

Kathy Calvin, CEO of the United Nations Foundation said, "Giving is not just about making a donation, it's about making a difference." While we are all adjusting to new norms resulting from the pandemic,
Charlotte County Habitat is staying on track as we prepare for our 2021 Apostles
Build and Women Build projects. We are determined now more than ever to
continue making a necessary and positive difference in our community.

Construction of our 11th Apostles Build home will begin in early January. We currently have nine (9) churches, who have participated in previous AB projects, returning to provide funding and volunteers. The home will be built in Punta Gorda, and the future homeowner is a single father, who is focused on providing a stable upbringing for his 3 year old son. Our church partners understand the current low-income housing need in Charlotte County and are ready to nail 2x4's, install siding and paint walls with smiles and prayers. Our goal is to have the home completed by mid-April.

Our Women Build project is scheduled to begin during February. We encourage Charlotte County women to join us in the construction of a home for a qualified single mother and her two young sons. Female volunteers enjoy replacing their kitchen aprons with nail aprons to help build an affordable, safe home and a positive future for a local family. Current health restrictions will be followed at the build sites to ensure the safety of our participants. We are looking forward to completing successful, fun builds and plan to show our strength and determination during these challenging times.
